

Palmyra School Board Member Elections November 6, 2018

To become a member of a local board of education in New Jersey, you must:

- Be able to read and write
- Hold U.S. citizenship and one year's residency in the school district
- Be registered to vote in the district before filing the nominating petition
- Have no interest in any contract with, or claim against, the board
- Not hold office as mayor or member of the municipal governing body
- Not simultaneously hold two elective offices
- Not be disqualified from membership for the conviction of certain crimes. (Within 30 days of election or appointment to the board, a member must undergo a criminal history background investigation through the state Department of Education)

Complete a nominating petition that includes the signatures of at least 10 qualified voters living within the district (one of which may be your own). A petition form may be picked up at the County Clerk's Office-49 Rancocas Road, 1st Floor, Mt Holly, NJ, 609-265-5122 or by following the link below. The petition must be submitted to the County Clerk on or before 4 p.m. on the last Monday in July (July 30th).
